### **Rules And Conduct**

# / RATING VERIFICATION

All Entrants must possess a registered DARTSLIVE Membership card with a rating determined by a minimum of 5 "01" games and a minimum of 5 Cricket games against opponents.

Only one DARTSLIVE Membership card shall be utilized for the entire event. Players shall use the highest card registered for DARTSLIVE League play Players possessing multiple cards and are not registered for DARTSLIVE League shall use the card with the highest rating.

Mandatory: Players must use the same DARTSLIVE Membership Card for the entire 2014 Hawaii Classic. No changing cards. PENALTY: Disgualification for the entire event.

There are limits on acceptable differentials between a Tournament Rating (the rating used by a player to enter the Hawaii Classic Events) and an Event Rating (the rating level the player is shooting in the Hawaii Classic Events). If a player's Event Rating exceeds their Tournament Rating by three or more points, said player's Tournament Rating will be rerated to their Event Rating at the conclusion of that event. Said rerating does not impact the teams and the standings within the flight from which the stats were derived. A player may be rerated more than once. Once a player is rerated, the new rating applies throughout the Hawaii Classic Events (cannot go down). If a

player is rerated twice, said player will be disqualified from further participation, will not receive prize money from the event in which the second rerate occurred and will not receive refunds for subsequent events. Said player's future eligibility Major Leisure Games Events will be determined after the Hawaii Classic Events.
